Memorandum of Understanding Sharps Container Pilot Program (SCPP)

The Sharps Container Pilot Program (SCPP) is a collaborative effort between the AIDS Foundation of Chicago and participating pharmacies and AIDS service organizations. The purpose of this program is to provide for the proper disposal of syringes purchased without a prescription by individuals pursuant to Public Act 093-0392.

By participating in the Sharps Container Pilot Program, the undersigned parties agree to the following:

- The agency shall distribute, free of charge, household sharps containers ordered through the Sharps Container Pilot Program only to individuals who are believed to use syringes for non-prescription purposes.
- The agency will cooperate with efforts to evaluate the efficacy of this program, including but not limited to maintaining records regarding the number of household sharps containers distributed during the pilot program.
- The AIDS Foundation of Chicago shall bear the expense of all sharps containers ordered and shipped for the Sharps Container Pilot Program.
- Should there be insufficient funds to maintain the pilot program, the AIDS Foundation of Chicago may terminate ordering privileges with 48 hours notice to participants.
