

## 2022 Ryan White Care RFP Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do I need to submit resumes and job description for already funded case managers?

A: No, only submit resumes, job descriptions, licensure, certificates for new positions. If your agency is currently not funded for RW services through AFC, you would need to submit these documents. Additionally, any certification and license renewals should also be submitted.

Q: Is there a budget template for non- case management services?

A: No, there is a narrative question in the RFP that contains questions related to fees and budget. State the dollar amount requested as part of question 8 in section 8.

Q: I am currently not Medicaid certified, but in the process of getting certified, can I still apply?

A: Yes.

Q: Will all services provided under Part A be cost reimbursement and all services under Part B be fee for service?

A: No, all case management services are cost reimbursement and all other services are fee for service.

Q: Do I submit one narrative for non-medical case management and one narrative for medical case management if I want to apply for both?

A: Yes, but if you want to apply for perinatal case management or corrections case management, you will have to submit separate responses to section 9.
