

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FLYER FOOD VOUCHERS

WHAT IS FOOD VOUCHER ASSISTANCE?

Food voucher assistance is available for eligible clients to ensure that eligible clients who are in need have access to supplemental food resources to promote their health and physical well being.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR FOOD VOUCHER ASSISTANCE?

- Clients who are ineligible for Public Aid assistance
- Clients whose Public Aid application is pending
- Clients who have an emergency situation (Example: Temporary loss of income, food stamps, or electricity)
- Clients who are not eligible for or have no access to other food options, such as those listed below
- Client must meet all agency eligibility criteria

WHAT IS REQUIRED OF CLIENTS TO OBTAIN FOOD VOUCHERS?

- The client must be assigned a Case Manager or enrolled in case management through the AIDS Foundation of Chicago's Cooperative
- The client must contact Case Manager and provide any needed documentation to prove financial need for food vouchers
