\$28.5 Million Investment in Supportive Housing Provides Stability and Safety for 12,000 Illinoisans, Saving them from Homelessness, Conserves Taxpayers' Money, & Helps Illinois Comply with Federal Consent Decrees

Modest State Commitment Leverages Significant Local & Federal Funds Already Secured for Projects

- In FY 2013, Illinois supportive housing providers served another 1,361 individuals by launching 34 projects with 824 units at a cost to Illinois of \$3 million.
- In FY 2014, providers are preparing to serve another 564 Illinoisans by launching 379 additional units at a cost of \$1.2 million.
- All told, with the projects coming online in FY 2014, supportive housing providers will serve nearly 12,000 Illinoisans with a total statewide budget of \$28.5 million.

This relatively modest investment will help keep Illinois compliant with the federal consent decrees while providing stability for individuals who might otherwise rely on far more expensive alternatives.
